They have produced materials that demonstrate how they are collaborating across Malvern Hills and the various groups that support their strategic plans.</li> <li>• <b>Increasing capacity, connectivity, and activity in non-medical mental health support across the district</b></li> <li>• <b>As part of tackling neighbourhood health inequalities</b>, the District Collaborative are looking at cervical screening uptake, especially in the deprived areas. The PCNs Cancer Care Co-ordinator, will help to contact these patients and Public Health are going to support with information and communication where this has been done before to increase uptake.</li> <li>• <b>Being Well Funding Bid</b> – to employ two Connected Wellbeing Services Coordinators. The Connected Wellbeing Services Coordinators will work collaboratively with their counterpart hosted organisation, other local VCS organisations and GP surgeries to increase capacity, connectivity and activity in non-medical mental health support across Malvern Hills district, with a focus on early intervention.</li> </ul>
