Funding:

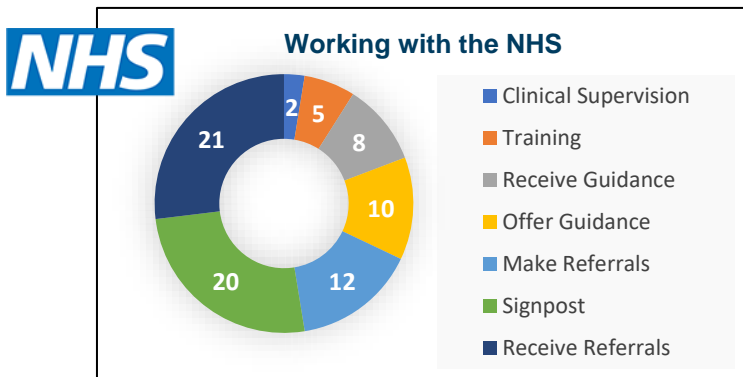
- Money to pay for training.

- 48% engage with Education Establishments

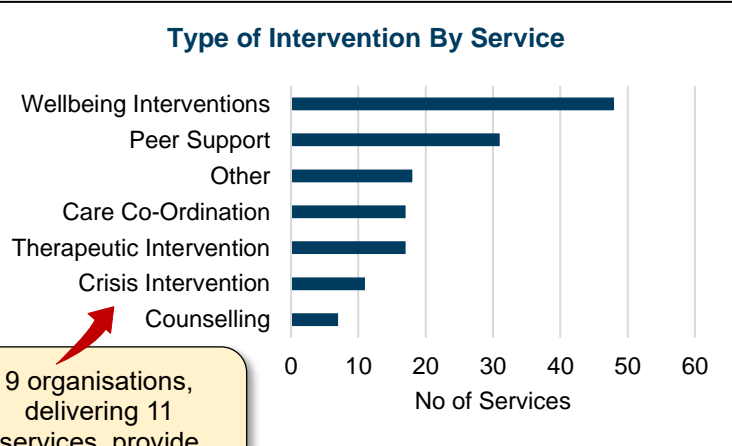
