## **Supporting Worcestershire Mental Health**

An update from Roger Britton on the Alliance Mental Health Support work...

'It is no secret that mental health services are struggling. Not because of any failure in the excellent clinical therapy on offer, nor because of any lack of commitment from professionals, but because there is a yawning gap between demand and the number of staff able to respond.

This is where the VCS has been able to step in. Not in the old model as a cheap way of filling a gap but proposing a new way of working.

We are at the beginning of a new era where VCS solutions are concreted in, working alongside and with parallel status to clinical specialisms. There is real money on the table, half a million pounds over the next year as well as a commitment to ongoing funding and the freedom to devise ways forward.'
